Membership Registration and Regulations 2026-2027

Our Missions

1. To undertake projects of publicity, education, recreation, counseling, clinical, audiological and medical services for the hearing impaired; and to assist or cooperate with any institutions, organizations or individuals to improve the services for the hearing impaired.
2. To work towards improving the educational standards for the hearing impaired, to provide scholarship and special equipment for the hearing impaired as well as to provide guidance for parents of hearing impaired children.
3. To inform the public about the problems and needs of the hearing impaired, to give necessary information to hearing impaired persons and their families about institutions and services available to them, and to exchange information among institutions serving the hearing impaired and to promote the concept of and to take steps to work towards the integration of the hearing impaired with the public.

2. Application Procedure

2.1 General Procedure

- a. Applicants should return the completed “Membership Registration Form” together with the following documents:
 - Copies of identity documents (e.g. HKID card, Birth Certificate): For confirming the applicant’s identity, age and residential address. Those documents will be destroyed after verification.
 - Copies of valid proof for hearing impairment (if applicable).
- b. Registration Method:
 - Registration in person: Please bring all the above documents together with the membership fee to the head office of the Society or the service centres within the opening hours to complete the application procedures. If the information provided is complete, ordinary membership card could be issued immediately with the receipt.
 - Application by mail : Applicants should return the completed form, with all the above documents, a crossed cheque payable to “The Hong Kong Society for the Deaf” together with a self-addressed envelope with HK\$2.2 postage stamp affixed to the Society. (Address: Rm 903, DWSSB, 15 Hennessy Road, Wan Chai. Please specify “The Hong Kong Society for the Deaf - Membership Application” on the envelope.)
- c. Membership will become effective and the card will be issued after the membership fee is received.
- d. The Council of the Society has the final discretion regarding the membership issue.

2.2 Application for Full / Life Member

Since all applications of Full / Life membership are to be approved by the Council, the membership card will not be issued immediately. Applicant will be notified after all verification procedures are completed. For any enquiries, please contact our colleague by tel: 2527 8969 or e-mail: headoffice@deaf.org.hk.

2.3 Application for Hearing Impaired Members

- a. The membership is applicable for applicant whose hearing loss of either ear reached 26dB or above. Applicant should provide supporting documents for verification together with the application form.
- b. The following documents are accepted as valid proof for hearing impairment:
 - Written documents issued by medical doctor / hearing centre
 - Document indicating that applicant is a recipient of disability allowance (for hearing disability)
 - Audiogram
 - Student card, handbook, report and other related information showing that applicant is a student of deaf school.
 - Registration card for disability issued by Labour and Welfare Bureau (the category of disability must include hearing impairment)
- c. If applicant fails to provide any of the information above, applicant will be accepted as “hearing member”. The applicant could also pay for the hearing test in the Society’s Audiology Centre. Applicant will be granted hearing impaired membership if the test result meets the requirement of 26 dB or above.

2.4 Applicant under the age of 18

- a. Applicant under the age of 18 should obtain the approval of parent / guardian by signing the application form.
- b. Hearing impaired members under 18 and their family members could also join our Parents Resource Centre without additional fees. Parent / guardian could provide the information and sign in the application form.

3. Membership Renewal

- a. Current members may come in person or by mail to renew their membership (for mailing application, please refer to the Society’s newsletter).
- b. If Full Members fail to renew their membership in three months after the expiry date, their Full Membership will be ceased and they can reapply as “ordinary members”; or otherwise at the discretion of the Council.

4. Loss / Damage of Card

Members may come to the Society's Head Office or service centres for a new card and HK\$20 administration fee is required for re-issuing a new card.

5. Withdrawal of Membership

Members or their families should contact the Head Office of the Society for withdrawal of membership. There will be no refund of membership fee.

6. Members' Rights and Duties

6.1 Rights

- a. All Life and Full members have the right to vote in the Society's AGM and are eligible to be elected as the committee members of the Council.
- b. All members possess the right to:
 - Receive the Society's newsletter*
 - Join the activities, services and courses organized by the Society**
 - Enjoy special discount for audiological services**
 - Purchase batteries, assistive device and discounted items**

6.2 Duties

All members should observe the regulations and duties below:

- Promote the missions and follow the regulations of the Society
- Renew their membership when membership expired
- Carry membership card when enjoying any service of the Society
- Should not engage in any activities against the objectives and interests of the Society. The Society reserves its right to claim damages.

7. Personal Data Use

7.1 The personal data for membership application will only be used in the following ways:

- To facilitate membership application;
- To promote the services and activities to members (e.g. mailing of newsletter);
- For planning and promotion of the Society's service;
- For research related to hearing impairment.

7.2 In accordance with the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, members have the right:

- To check whether the Society holds data about them and of access to such data;
- To correct any inaccurate data relating to them;
- To request for the Society's policies and practices on personal data use.
